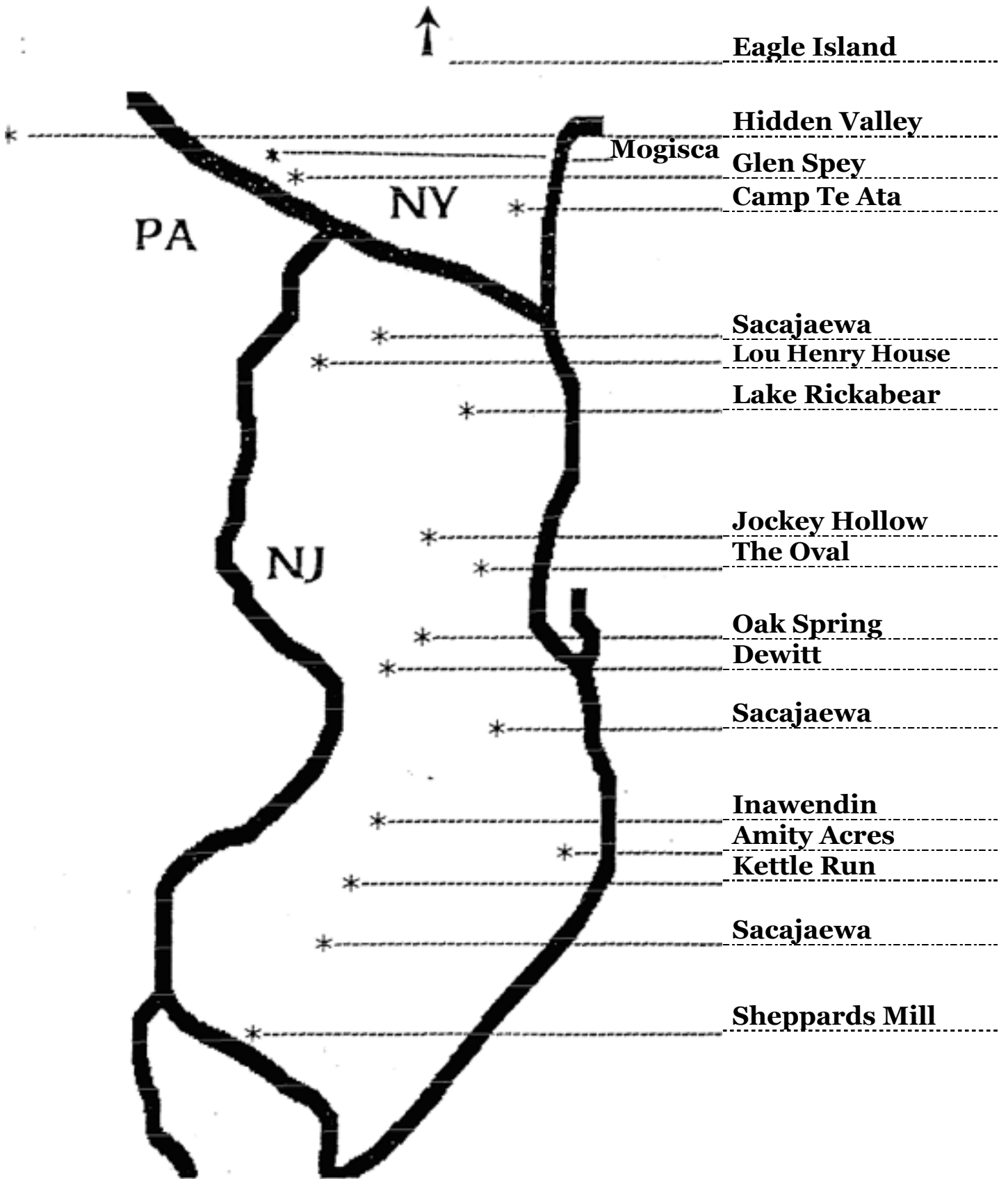

THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO ALL CAMPS

TO REGISTER: Call or write for information (such as vacancies and applications to the council which has the camp in which you are interested. Their application * will have to be signed by your council before processing.
*(if required)

FEES: Contact the council whose camp you are interested in for their camp's current fees.

INSURANCE: Certificates of Insurance are provided by each council to all other councils annually. Non-Girl Scout groups must have liability coverage.

SAFETY WISE: You must adhere to Girl Scouts of the USA standards and activity guidelines while camping, as well as specific camp rules and regulations as set by individual councils.

CAMP CERTIFICATION:

An adult accompanying the troop/group on their camping trip, must have completed camp certification training to camp at ALL Girl Scout sites.

FIRST AID: ALL Girl Scout sites require that each troop/group have a person currently qualified in First Aid, an RN, EMT, Paramedic or licensed Medical Doctor with them during their trip.

Camp Glen Spey, NY

- Description:** 600 acres of pristine woodland completely surrounding a 70 acre natural lake. The terrain is rocky, with a forest made up of primarily Oak, with some stands of Hemlock. The lake is home to fish, beaver and otter. A camp ranger is on duty at all times.
- Facilities:** Troop house - (3) capacity; maximum 30.
Winterized, with stove, refrigerator, hot and cold water, showers and flush toilets. Available from January to November.
- Tent Units:** North Side (4) tents on platforms with centralized bath house, hot water showers and flush toilets.

South Side (2) tents on platforms with centralized bath house, hot water showers, flush toilets, kitchen shelter with cold water and fireplace.
- House trailer:** (1) capacity 7. Winterized, kitchen facilities, living room, toilet facility, hot and cold water. Available from September to November 15 and January to June.

- Description:** 286 Acres of pine and oak trees surrounding an 11 acre Cedar lake. Soil is sandy and terrain flat with Mountain Laurel and blueberries. The center provides a full-time ranger and weekend site director couples. Cooking equipment is available at no charge. Easy travel to Atlantic City and Philadelphia.

Camp, Inawendiwin, Northeast of Medford, NJ

Description: Located off of Route 70 E, 2 miles past the intersection of 206 and 70, northeast of Medford, NJ. 540 acre site with three lakes, sandy pine barren environment, wild blueberry, laurel, pine and oak forests and insect eating plants. (Lou Henry Hoover Wildlife Sanctuary). In inclement weather there are two enclosed kitchen buildings with tables and wood stoves which are shared by troops using the camp. Camp Ranger on site year round.

Facilities: Platform tents- each tent unit has seven (4) person tents and a fire pit. Available April to November 7 days a week. Cots and mattresses.

Buildings: Available year round. Mattresses available. Heated November to March.

- Description:** 120 acres of rolling hills, streams and woodlands. Facilities include: sports field, boating and canoeing, nature trails and swimming pool. The property has frontage on the historical Delaware Raritan Canal. Ranger on site, Site directors are provided weekends during May, June, September and part of October. Facilities are available during the week.

- Facilities:** (9) platform tent units- Available April 20 to October 15 (not July and August) 4 persons per tent.
- Waterfront Cabin:** capacity 8 people, electricity, fireplace heat, latrine, available April to October (not July or August).
- Infirmary:** Capacity 16 electricity heated cabin, available year round (not July or August), indoor bathroom, water from caretaker.
- Main House:** First floor heated, indoor bathroom, 4 bedroom with bunkbeds, kitchen and dining hall for large group food serving. Available year round. Swimming, boating and canoeing on White Lake.

Description: Wooded site in the South Mountain Reservation with a large open playing field in the center of 10 cabins.

Facilities: (9) cabins capacities 12-40. Each cabin has a bathroom with flush toilets, kitchen with propane stove and oven, refrigerator and fireplace heat. Outside are Picnic tables and cooking fireplaces.

- Description: 125 acres heavily wooded site, relatively flat terrain. Lake is a former cranberry bog fed by a controlled stream. Ranger lives on site.
- Facilities: Lakeside Activity Center- capacity 36 Available January to December seven days a week. Weekends only in June to August.
- Platform Tent Units – capacity each unit 36, available April 15 June 30 and September to October, seven days a week. Available on weekends only in June to August.

Description: 200 acres of woodland adjacent to Jockey Hollow National Historical Park. There are marked hiking trails. Within walking distance to National Historical Park, Wick Farm and Visitor Center. No on site personnel. Emergency contact nearby.

Facilities: Facilities are available from September through mid-June, seven days a week.

Fingarr Lodge- cabin, capacity 30. Heat, electricity, refrigerator, stove and running water for inside cooking and eating equipment, 30 bunks with foam mattresses, telephone, fireplace, latrines. Barrier free.

- Description:** 152 acres in Sourland Mountains containing stream, fields and Full time caretaker year round. Olympic size swimming pool is available June – August.
- Facilities:** Dewitt Cabin- large room with fireplace and wood stove tables and chairs, electric lights, screened porch kitchen with range, refrigerator, hot and cold water. Capacity 20 day use, 15 overnight- Available September - June.

Excellent winter program possibilities, sledding, snow-shoeing, and ice skating, with a downhill ski area just (3) miles away. Beautiful hiking trails, and nearby horseback riding facilities. Full time caretaker on-site year round.
- Facilities:** Johnson Lodge- capacity 32 day use, 13 overnight use. Two large rooms, 1 with fireplace. Kitchen with refrigerator, range, hot and cold water. (2) separate bedrooms, (2) bathrooms, tables, chairs, mattresses. Electricity.

Description: Camp Lou Henry Hoover is our 328 acre camp in Middleville, Sussex County, NJ. The land offers a wide variety of terrain and habitats to explore including frontage on mile long Swartswood Lake. It is available to Girl Scout Groups, religious, social and fraternal groups weekends, and Monday through Friday, September through June. The camp offers many fun-filled activities and equipment for all seasons including hiking trails, sports fields, a team building/challenge low ropes course, campfire settings, and wintertime activities. Townley Hall, our Program Center, offers a beautiful indoor recreation room and outdoor deck ideal for dances, indoor sports, games and campfires. Our lakefront offers swimming, ice skating, fishing, sun-bathing, canoeing and rowboating (no motor boats permitted). Come anytime. There's lots to do! Groups using the ropes course and waterfront must provide their own qualified supervision. Accommodations range from modern indoor living to tent pitching. Bring your personal gear and food, we provide cooking equipment.
